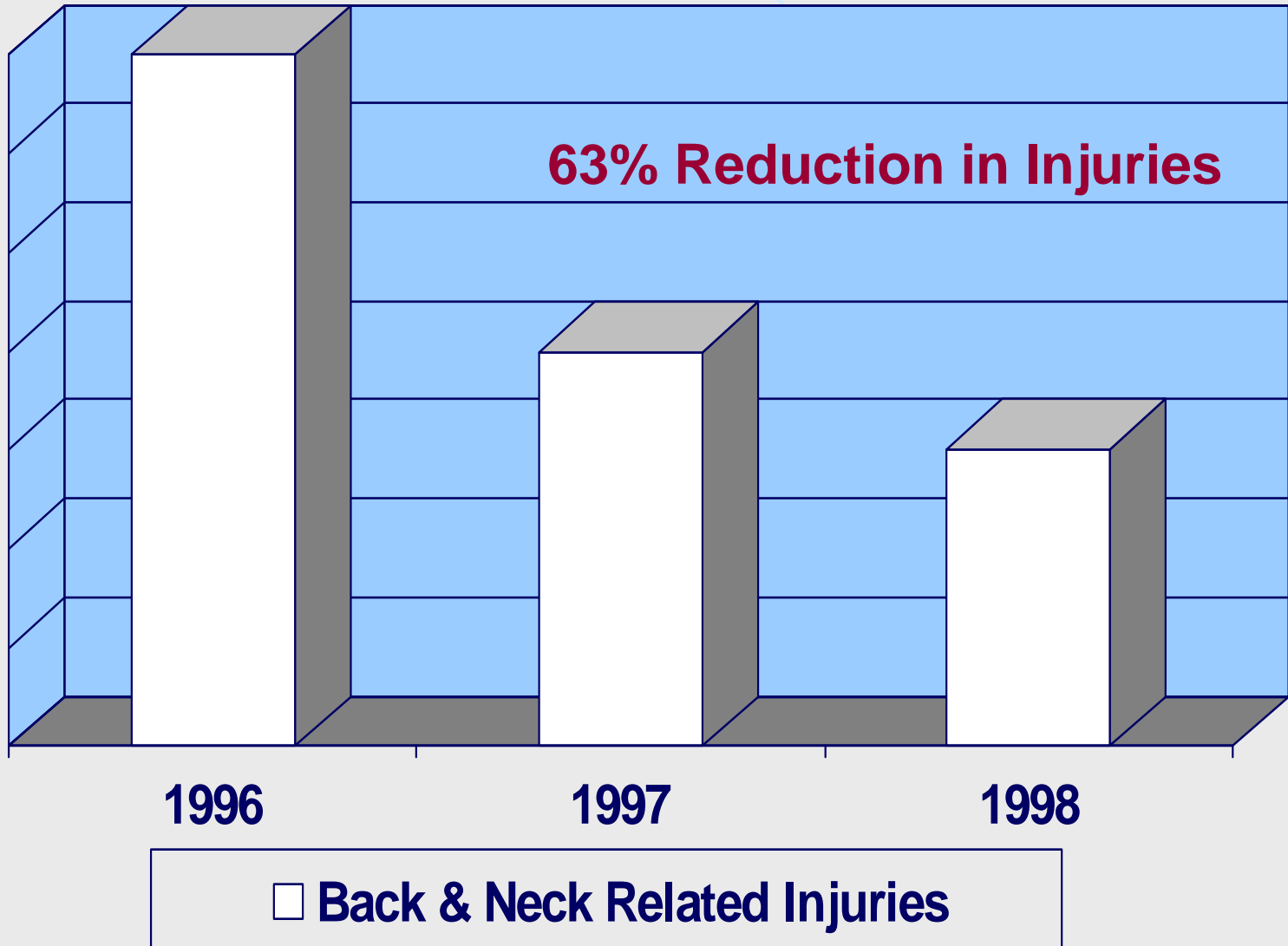

Results

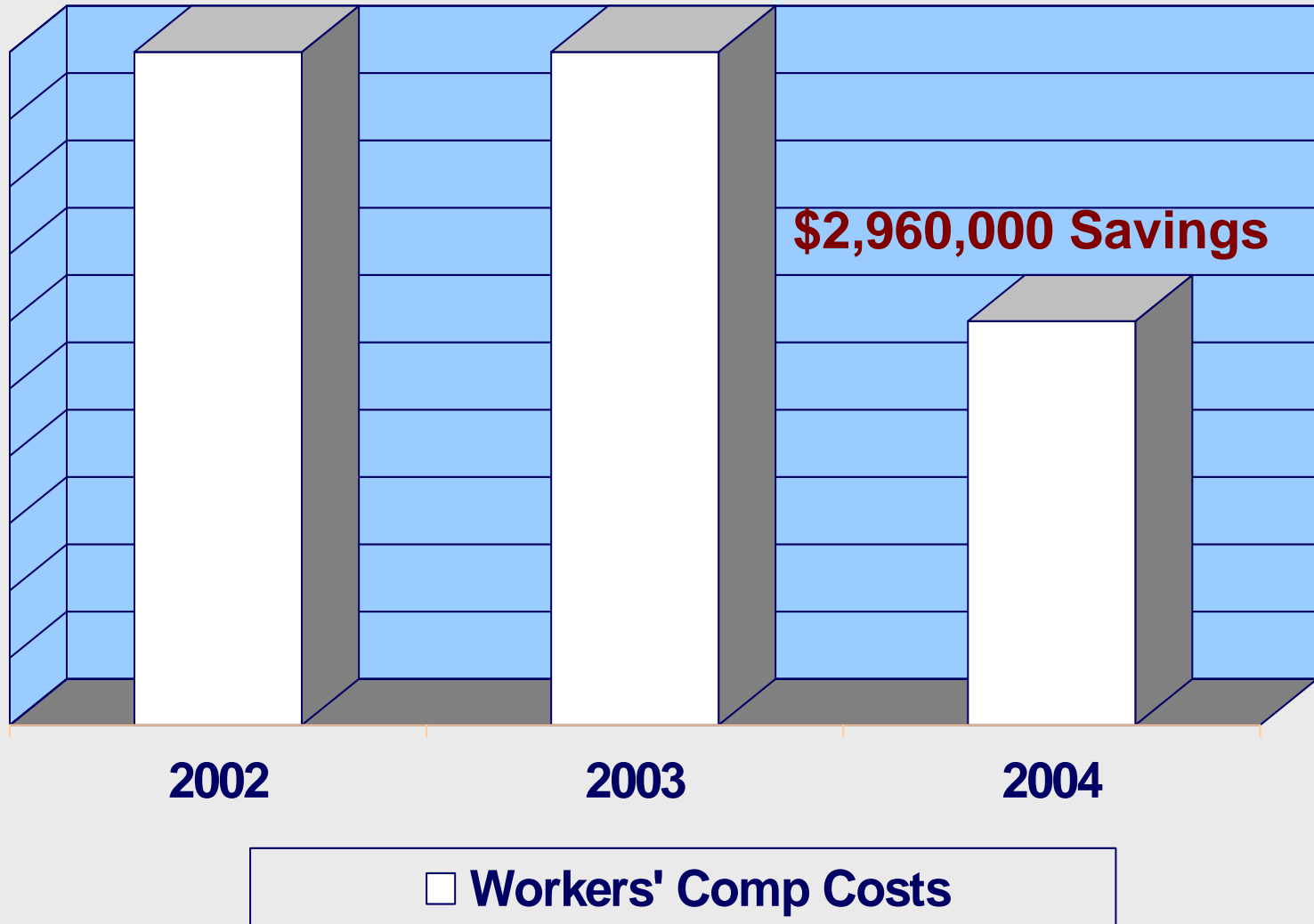


- 63% reduction in back & neck injuries.

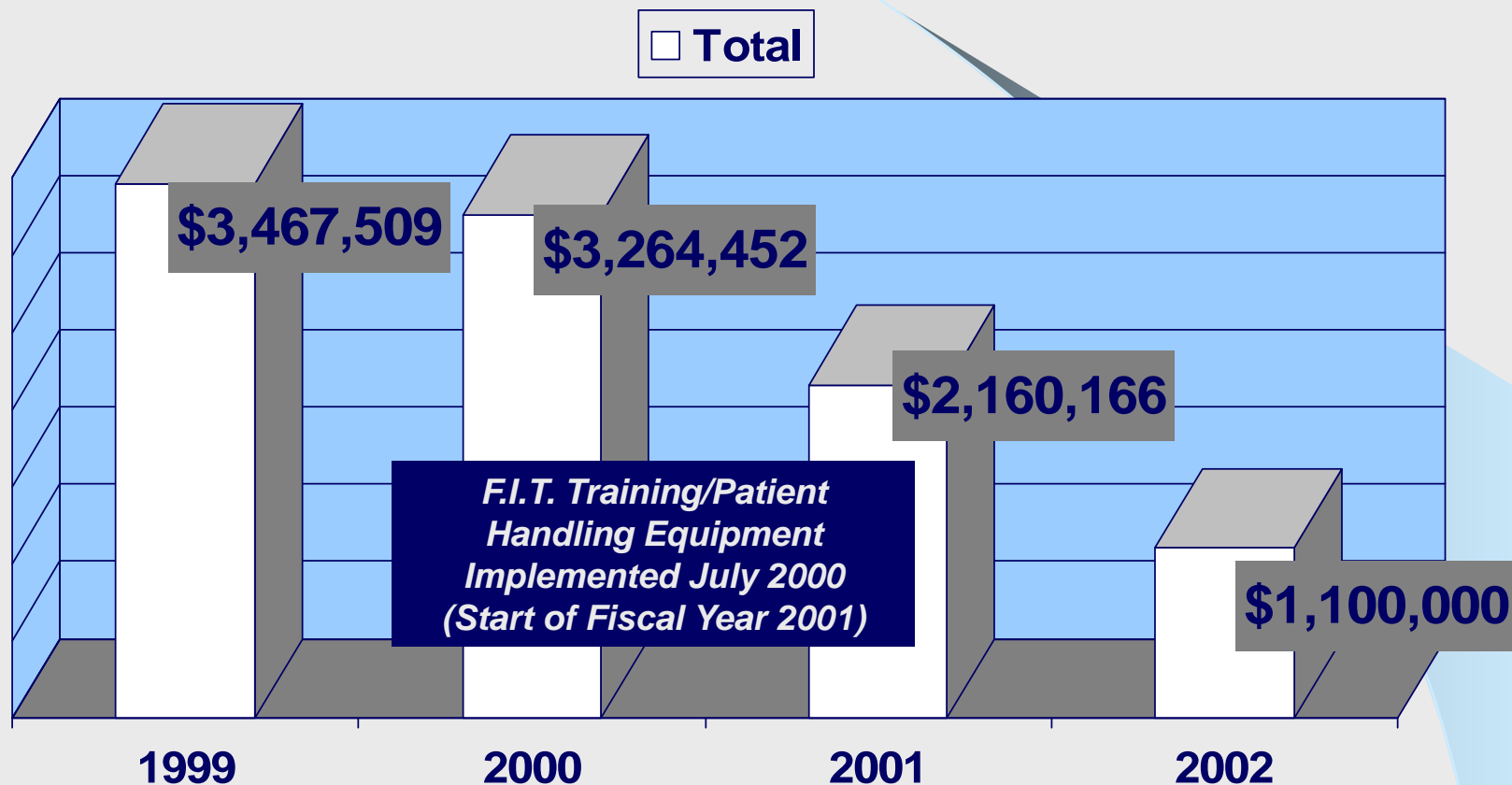
United Airlines Ramp Personnel

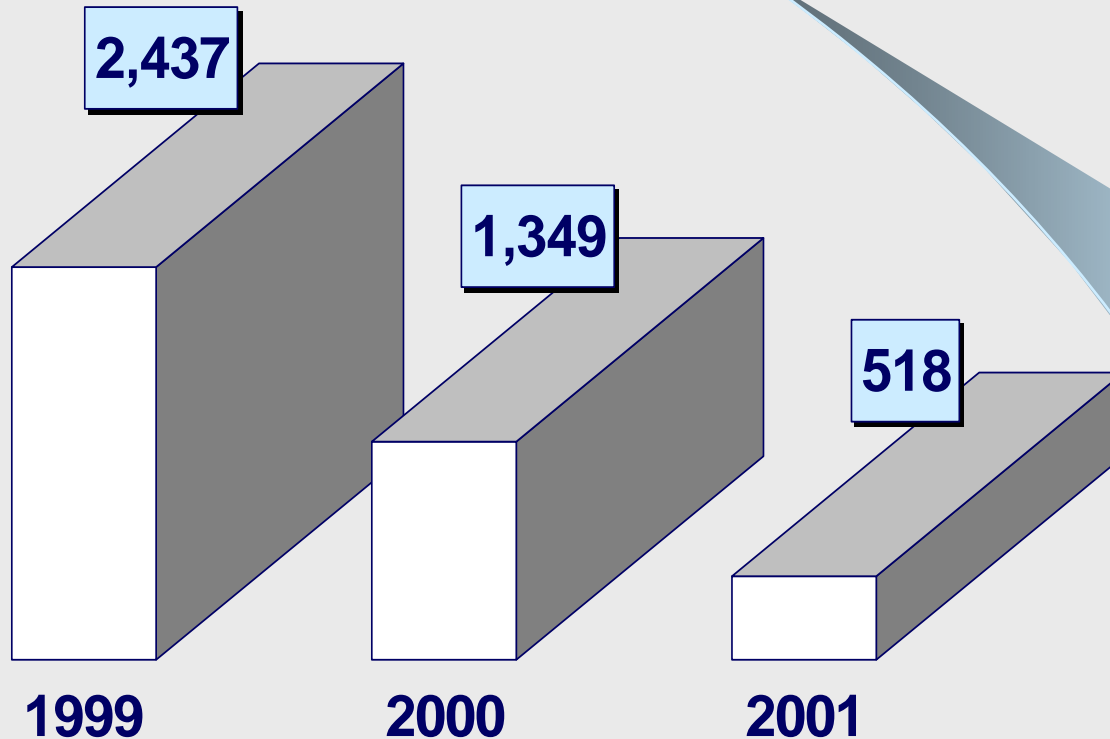
Hillcrest Medical Center Claims Summary By Year

Lost Work Days Summary By Year



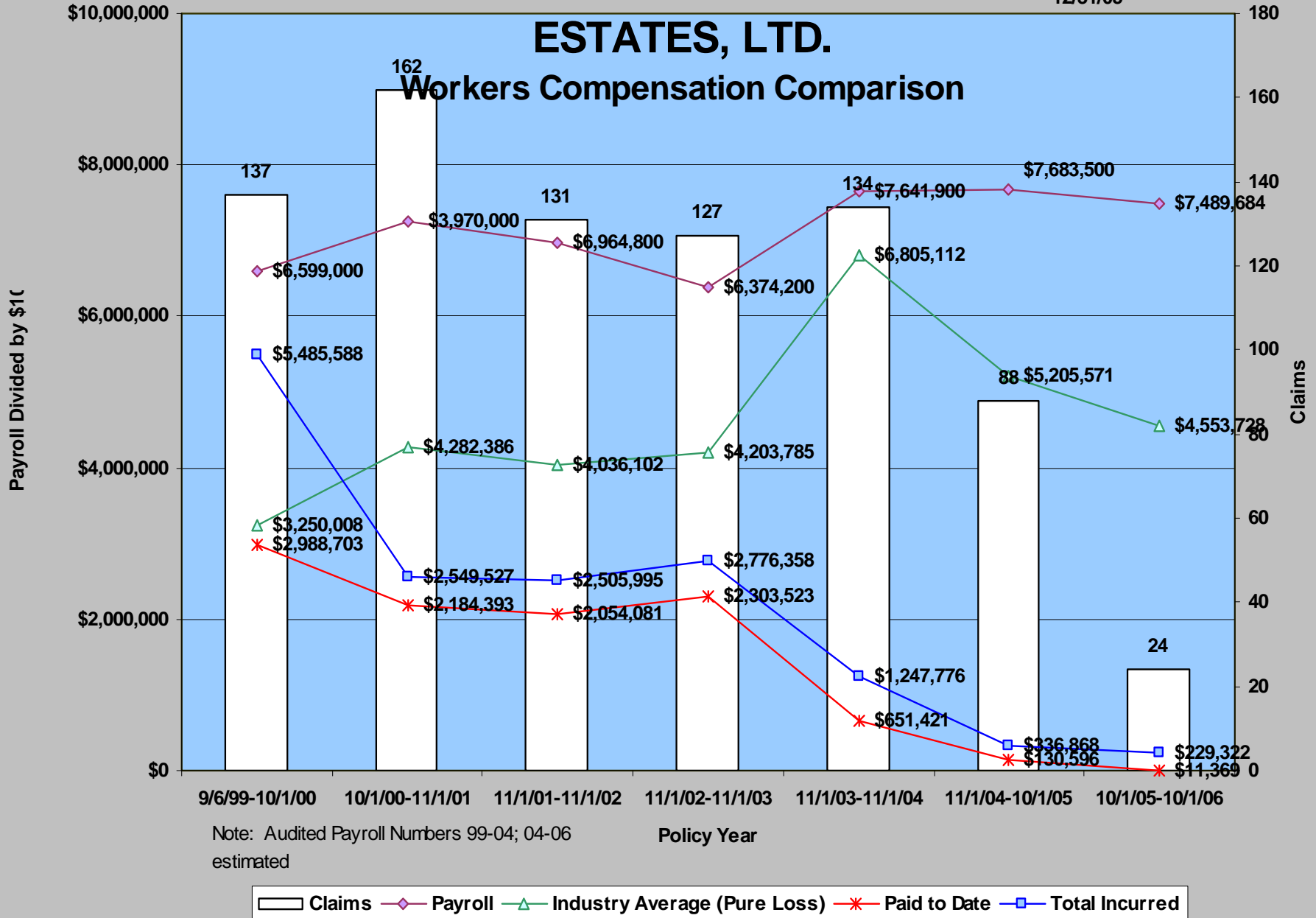

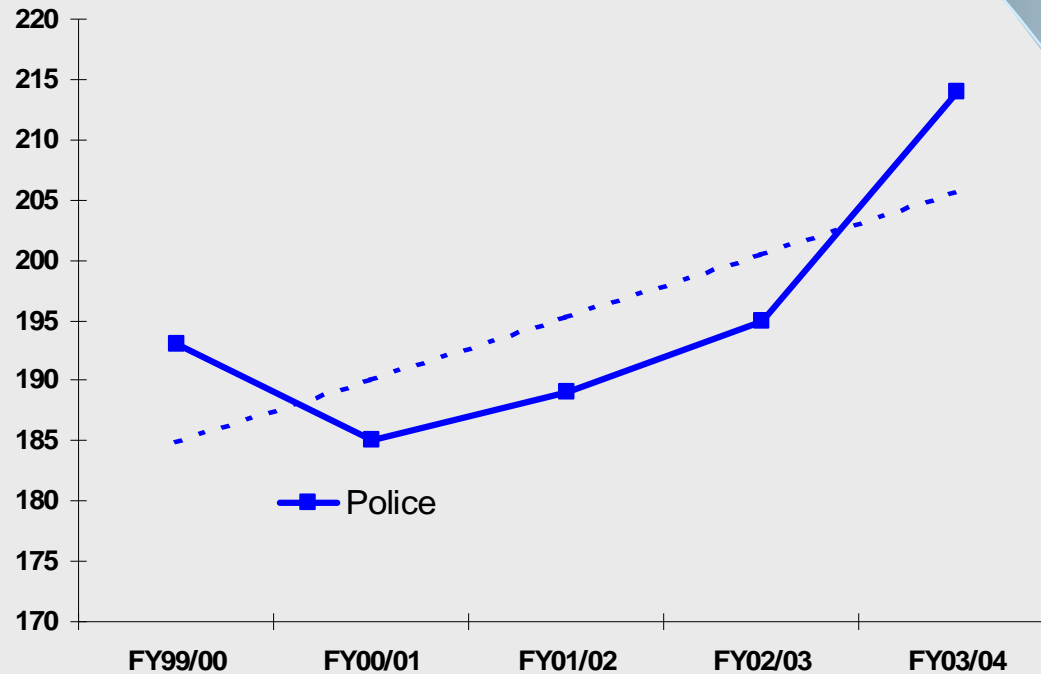

Workers Compensation Comparison



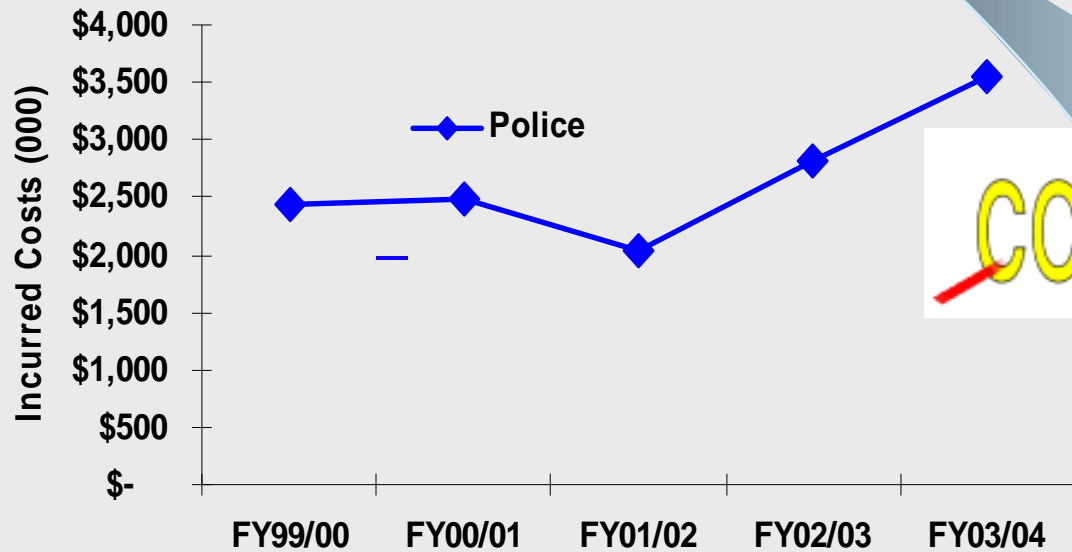
Municipal Pooling Authority of Northern California Claims Frequency Trend 1999 - 2004



Frequency After 24 Months

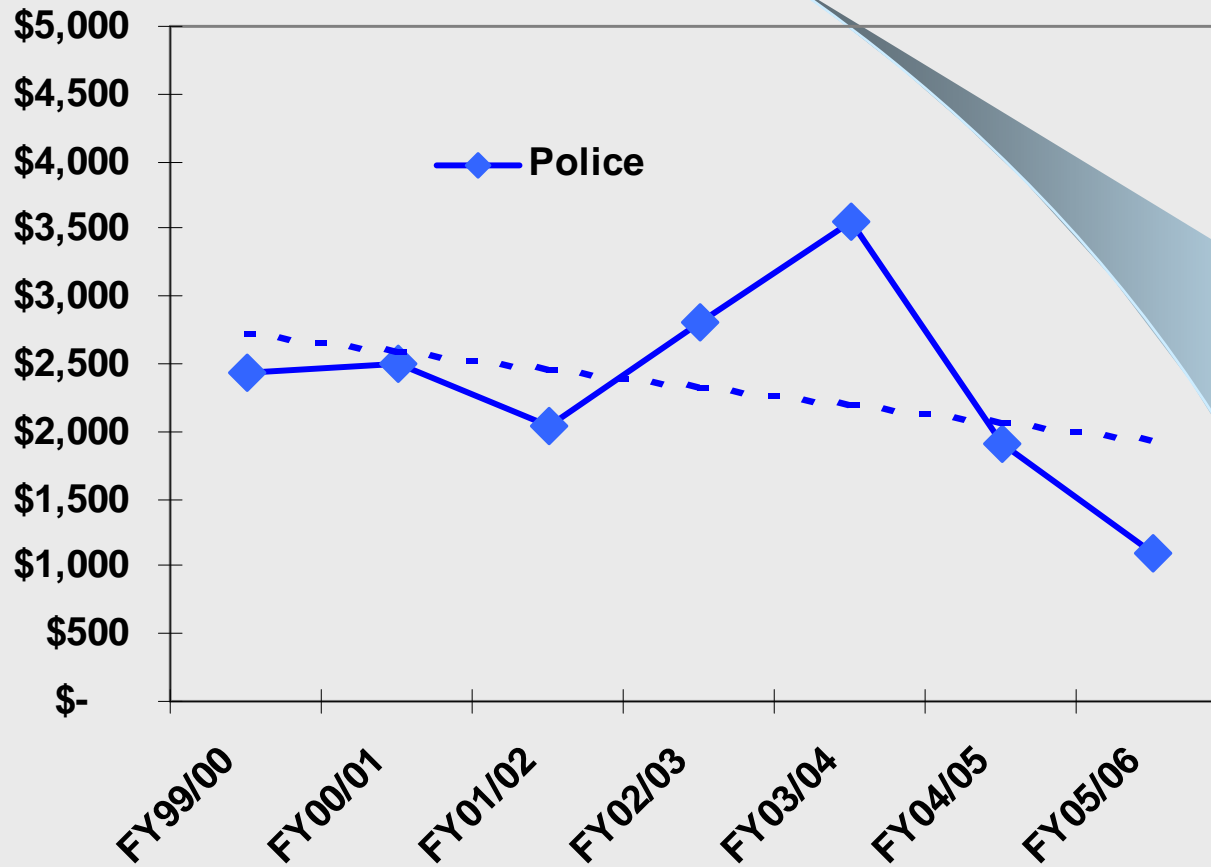


Incurred Cost Trend 1999 - 2004
